WILLIAM LYLE BROWN



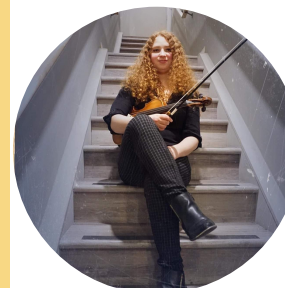
